

Read to WIN



Dear Parent,

Your child's class is taking part in **Laser City's Read to Win Contest**, an exciting way to reward students for reading! The contest is designed to encourage children to build reading into their daily routine and by doing so, qualifies them for a chance to win 2 free games of laser tag at Laser City.

How The Contest Works

1. Every month the students will be given a Reading Sheet to fill in. The teacher will specify whether they need to read a chapter or an entire book for it to qualify
2. The student will ask you to sign off on their reading as they complete each line
3. Once the sheet is full, the student will drop the sheet into the Entry Box in their classroom for their chance to win a double guest pass for laser tag at Laser City
4. The student is welcome to fill in as many sheets as they can during the month – meaning the more they read, the more chances they have to win
5. Every month your teacher will draw a sheet from the box and award the certificate to the winner for the free games of laser tag
6. The teacher will then start the contest again, so the student has a chance to win every month!
